

We are pleased to announce that in October the Hoboken Public Library will offer 10 Hoopla checkouts for Hoboken Library Resident Cardholders. Hoopla provides online access to over 15,000 videos (including movies and TV shows), over 14,000 audiobooks, and over 200,000 music albums, plus access eBooks including graphic novels/comics!
