

HPL's New Creation Space!

The Library is opening its brand new makerspace -The Hoboken Creation Space! Makerspaces are places where creativity and learning are fostered through the availability of tools, technology, and training. Our Creation Space will feature both specific classes and projects for kids, teens, and adults. The space will also be open once a month for anyone to come and use any of the tools! Here are some of the things our space will have available: 3D Printer, 3D scanner, Laptops with CAD software, Arduino starter kits, Makey Makey kits, and a VEX Robotics kit. There will be a Photography Station, SLR digital camera, green screen, lighting, inkjet printer, and a laptop with Adobe Creative Suite. A Music Recording Station will include a midi keyboard, microphones, mixer, and a Macbook Pro with GarageBand to record your songs and music. Button Makers are available for designing and making your own pin buttons.

Make 3D Printed Cookie Cutters
