DIY: Recycled Sculpture Art

In December's installment of our Hoboken Do-It-Yourself program series, local artist Jordan Andre De Liso will teach two hands-on programs on creating homemade sculptures using recycled materials. Each student will work with materials provided and create an art piece during the class. There will be two classes suited for individuals of different skill levels.

On Wednesday, December 7th at 6:00pm, class #1 will cover an introduction to materials, strategies, mechanics and assembly followed by a hands-on creation workshop.

On Wednesday, December 14th at 6:00pm, class #2 will cover perspectives of found object art, a continuation of the previous class' lessons and another creation workshop.
