#### Make A Splash Kids' Summer Reading Program

Make a Splash – Read! is the Hoboken Library's Summer Reading program for kids from kindergarten through 5th grade. The program starts on July 6. Kids keep track of the hours they read from July 6 to Aug. 26 on "time trackers" and get prizes at 1, 5, 10, 15, and 20 hours. "Super Splash" readers compete for the most hours read. The winning reader gets 4 tickets to the Hoboken Clearview Cinemas, and two runners-up get 2 tickets, each. Everyone who reads and reports on their hours gets great prizes and an invitation to the Super Splash Reading Celebration on August 26.
