January Displays @ the Library

Picturing America Artwork
This January our picturing America Artwork will feature pictures of two famous buildings, one that can be viewed across the Hudson, The Chrysler Building, and another much farther away, the state capital building in Columbus, Ohio. The Chrysler Building is a gorgeous art deco sky scraper built at the end of the 1920's. The Ohio State capital was built in the Greek Revival Mode between 1838 and 1861.

Martin Luther King Display

Beginning the week of Martin Luther King's Day and here through February, the library will feature a display on one of the greatest civil rights leaders of all time, Martin Luther King Jr. We also have beautiful and historic photographs of King taken by Benedict J. Fernandez on permanent display.

New Languages Offered by Mango

Mango has now added new languages including: Arabic (Leventine), Farsi, Pashto, Urdu, Turkish, Hebrew, Korean, Vietnamese, Thai, Tagalog, Hindi, and Irish. Chinese (Mandarin), French, German, Greek, and Italian continue to be offered. English as a Second Language courses are also available

including ESL Spanish, ESL French, ESL Italian, ESL German, ESL Russian, ESL Mandarin Chinese, ESL Cantonese Chinese, ESL Japanese, ESL Greek, ESL Arabic, ESL Korean, ESL Vietnamese, ESL Portuguese, and ESL Polish. The link for Mango is at the bottom of the library home
