Fall Weekly Children's Programs begin Sept. 12th!

Weekly programs are limited to Hoboken children with library cards. Story times are open to the first fifteen attendees on the day of the program.

Baby and Me: Ages 6 to 18 months. Every 2nd and 4th Monday at 11 AM. Simple stories, songs, and nursery rhymes.

Toddler Time 1: Ages 19 to 30 months. Tuesday at 10:30 AM. Program repeats on Thursday at 10:30 AM. Children may attend only one per week.

Toddler Time 2: Ages 31 months to 4 years. Wednesday at 10:30 AM. Stories, songs, and a craft.

After School Story Time: Ages 3 ½ to 5 years. Thursdays at 3:15 PM. Stories, songs, and craft or coloring sheet.

Stories for Children with Special Needs: all ages. Simple stories, games, songs, puppets, and sensory activities for children with developmental disabilities, autism spectrum, and visual or physical handicaps. First Wednesday of the month (Sept 7th) at 3:15.
