How to find materials:

Visit catalog.bccls.org to search for materials from the BCCLS website. The BCCLS Library network is made up of over 78 libraries. Materials from other libraries can be delivered to any of HPL's branches or lockers. An account can have 50 items out at one time.

How to return materials:

Please return magazines, media, and delicate items to a staff member inside. All other items can be returned in the book drop or locker returns outside 24/7.

Library fees:

We are fine-free! This policy excludes damaged, lost, or special items (see below). Accounts owing \$10 or more for fine-free exempt items will be unable to check out or renew items until fines are paid. Fine-free is for Hoboken materials only, meaning **loans from other BCCLS libraries may incur fines** based on the owning library's policy.

Items that will not incur late-fee charges:


